Blood Testing (For MMA Contestants)

WVAC POLICY #110916

By unanimous vote in an open meeting on November 9, 2016 the West Virginia Athletic Commission adopts the following policy:

Effective January 1, 2017, all MMA Combatants are required to submit a report of the standard combative trio blood tests performed no more than 12 months prior to the date of the contest in which he or she is participating.

This is in accordance with §177-2-53 Medical Testing Requirements of the State Code of West Virginia which states:

53.1 A contestant shall submit evidence to the Commission that the contestant is free of Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and proof of passing a Hepatitis Band a (sic) Hepatitis C virus test. The Commission will only accept laboratory results that are no older than twelve (12) months.

53.4 A contestant who fails may not participate in a match.

This policy will remain in effect until rescinded or replaced.
