

Criteria for Professional Fighter

WVAC POLICY #091522

By unanimous vote in an open meeting on September 15, 2022, the West Virginia Athletic Commission unanimously adopts the following policy regarding amateur fighters seeking professional licensure:

Any amateur boxer seeking a professional license in West Virginia must show evidence of a minimum of three (3) verifiable bouts consisting of three (3) 3-minute rounds.

Promoters may schedule amateur boxing bouts of 3 rounds of either 2 or 3-minute duration.

This policy replaces policy #030118 enacted on March 1, 2018, and will remain in effect until amended, replaced, or rescinded.
